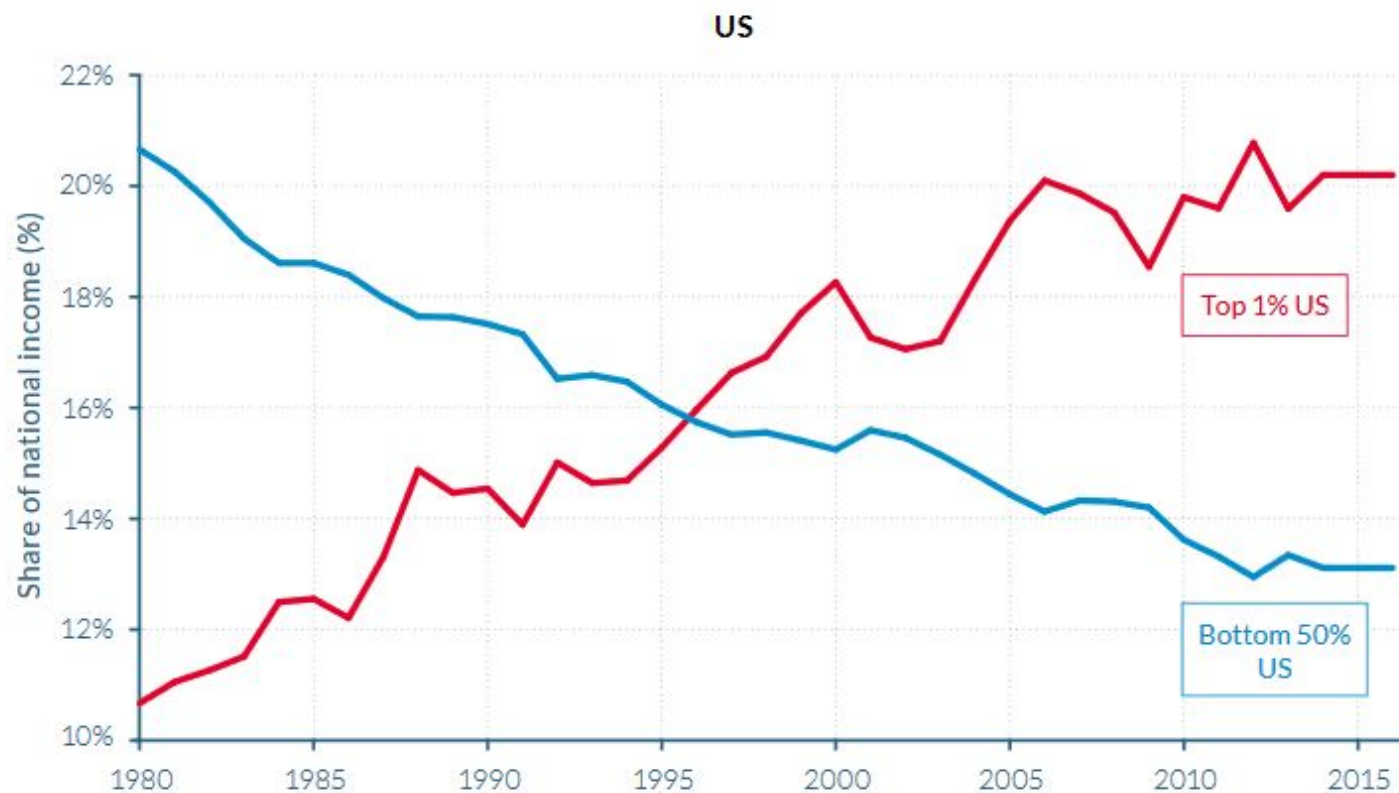

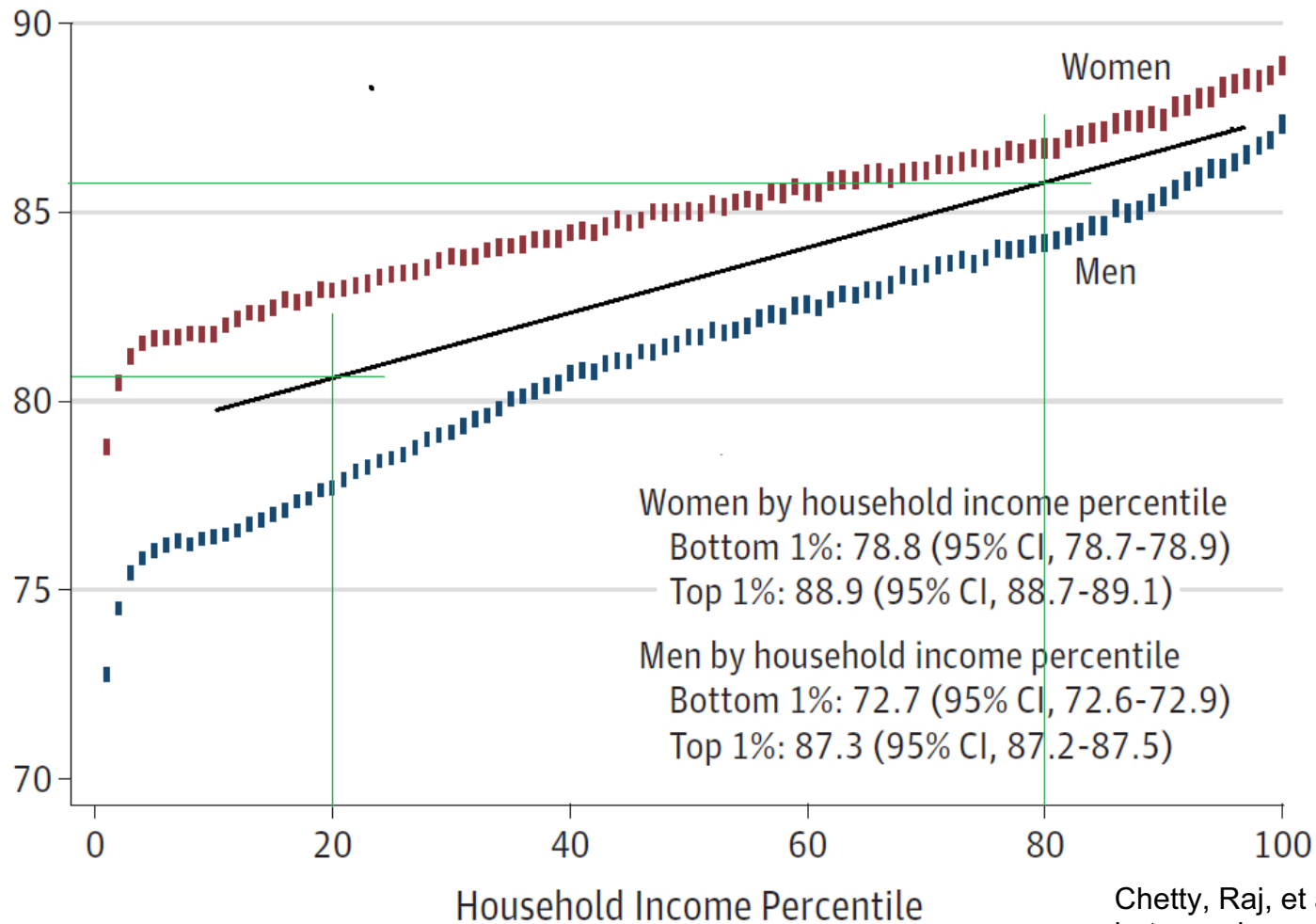
Top 1% vs. Bottom 50% national income shares in the US and Western Europe, 1980-2016:
