GOAL:

The Capacity Building Assistance initiative provides programmatic funding to organizations to serve as subject matter experts for each of the three strategic plan focus areas (food, housing, and mental and behavioral health), as well as for organizational infrastructure. The organizations will work over the grant period to provide short- or longer-term support to Community Resilience Initiatives (CRI) grantees to assess their capacity-building needs, provide tailored and general learning and growth opportunities, and create tools and resources necessary to advance their work.
